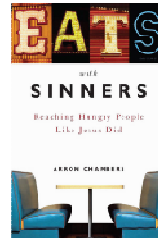

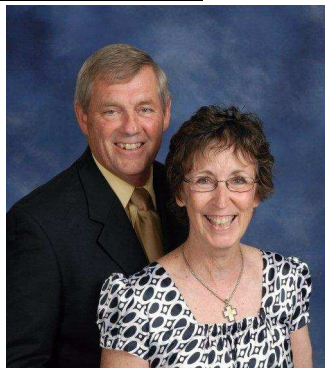


Baby Recognition
